The **2008 Global NSEE Workshop** will showcase best practices, generate new ideas, and strengthen ties among NSEE professionals from around the world.

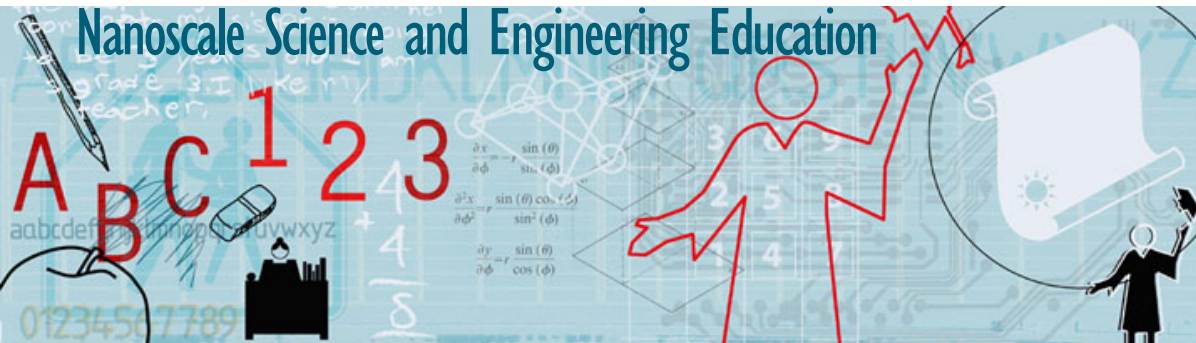
Participants will:
